


The Ground Coordination Function.

Two paradigm shifts in airport operations.

1. Local integration

- > **Connect the different operators at one airport**
- > **Connect the airport to the network (horizontal integration step 1)**


2. Network integration

- > **Connect the network to the airports (horizontal integration step 2)**
- > **Connect the NOP and AOP (horizontal integration step 3)**
- > **Connect airports to each other (vertical integration step 1)**



The objectives of the ATM Master Plan can best be reached by the cooperation between NOP & AOP




A global collaborative environment for real performance in the turn around process.



The most critical part of the future business trajectory is the TMA and turn around part. Real performance in the turn around process can only be delivered by a global collaboration of operational stakeholders.

In what policy frameworks does the ground coordinator fit ?



- **SES.**
- Network Management : ground coordinator
- Performance Framework : performance of ground operations, esp. turn around process.
- Technological pillar (SESAR) : deployment of AOP/NOP – APOC
- **Ground Handling** : coordination of the actors
- **Slots** : reconciliation of Airport and ATFM slots
